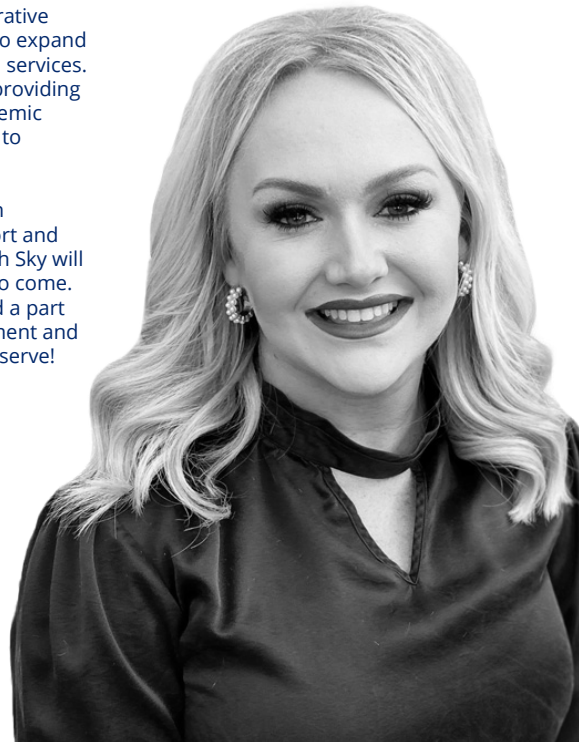

High Sky's on-campus emergency shelter provides temporary placement for children in foster care while long-term placement is secured, ensuring sibling groups stay together, offering trauma-informed care, basic needs fulfillment, and assigning each child a Case Manager for comprehensive support.

High Sky's Teen Home offers long-term placement for adolescent youth in foster care, providing a home-like environment with 24-hour caregivers trained in trauma-informed practices. This program fosters normal teenage experiences, teaches life skills, and assigns each youth a Case Manager for comprehensive support in medical, behavioral, mental health, and educational needs.

Preparation for **Adult Living (PAL)**

The Preparation for Adult Living (PAL) program equips teenage foster youth, aged 16 to 17 with essential life skills through a comprehensive four-day training covering health, safety, job readiness, financial management, and more. Participants engage in various activities, receive educational presentations, and undergo Casey Life Skills Assessments to identify their needs and strengths, providing valuable insights for their transition into adulthood.

The program includes licensing foster and kinship families, performing adoptions for children in care, and providing comprehensive training, support, and resources to ensure every child finds a safe and nurturing home, either temporarily through fostering or permanently through adoption.

Through one-on-one sessions, PWP empowers parents to cultivate and restore healthy relationships with their children, enabling families to thrive together.

Stay Together

The Stay Together Program offers comprehensive support to families with children from birth to age 17 across 33 counties, focusing on fostering positive relationships through personalized services.

Family Support Specialists conduct in-home visits and address issues like conflict resolution, discipline, child development, and school behavior. Through evidence-based curriculum, the program promotes parenting techniques, family strengths, child development education, and youth skill development. Additional services include crisis intervention, case management, advocacy, basic needs support, and free workshops to the community.

The Five Protective Factors:

Parental Resilience: The ability to recover from difficult life experiences, and often to be strengthened by and even transformed by those experiences.

Social Connections: The ability and opportunity to develop positive relationships that lessen stress, isolation, and help to build a supportive network.

Knowledge of Parenting and Child Development: The ability to exercise effective parenting strategies to guide and know what to expect as children develop in multiple domains (physical, cognitive, language, social, and emotional).

Concrete Support in Times of Need: Access to supports and services that reduce stress and help to make families stronger.

Social and Emotional Competence of Children: Family and child interactions that help children develop the ability to communicate clearly, recognize and regulate their emotions, and establish and maintain relationships.
